Sub: Final Bi-monthly State Distribution Order of S.K. Oil under NFSA for the month of **October & November, 2018.**

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to communicate the District-wise/Wholesaler-wise/FPS-wise distribution order of 41,004.069 KL of S.K. Oil for the month of **October & November, 2018** for distribution among the Priority Households (PHH) and Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) households under NFSA-2013 as per enclosed **Annexure-I**. The Wholesaler-wise/FPS-wise distribution list has been provided in all RCMS logins for download and dissemination among concerned Stakeholders.

The Wholesaler-wise Distribution has been generated from the system based on the online mapping of FPSs & Cards carried out by the concerned districts in RCMS login. In case of minor mapping issues resulting in fraction quantities required to be re-allotted to a Wholesaler/FPS Dealer, it should be done with sufficient justification after due approval of Collector. Accordingly, tagging should be updated in the CSO login of RCMS.

The bi-monthly entitlement of S.K. Oil is 5 (five) litres per card (2.500 litres per card per month) which should be distributed on 'first come first serve' basis. The selling price of S.K. Oil for the district shall be fixed by the Collector of the district based on the cost of S.K. Oil & transportation charges as applicable till FPS point. The concerned ACSO/Inspector of Supplies/Marketing Inspector of the Block/ULB is responsible for correct reflection of selling price by the FPS Dealer in the generated slip from PoS device.

The following timelines have been fixed for carrying out different activities related to lifting and distribution of S.K. Oil which shall be adhered to scrupulously:

It is requested to make adequate publicity & awareness among beneficiaries/PRI members and other Stakeholders regarding the dateline of distribution so that nobody is deprived of their entitlement for the allotment month.

The S.K. Oil wholesalers may be instructed suitably to lift their allotted quota from the tagged Depots of OMCs by the above dateline without fail and ensure delivery to FPSs tagged to them.

Distribution of S.K. Oil at FPS point should be made only through e-PoS device wherever PoS device has been delivered to the FPS. Sales through manual mode should be discouraged as far as practicable. However, in case of any exigencies or in worst circumstances, such manual mode of distribution should be resorted to only after due approval of concerned BDO/EO with proper justification.

In order to bring transparency in S.K. Oil distribution, sales registers of exclusive S.K. Oil FPSs have been dropped in the e-PoS devices of nearby composite FPSs (FPS distributing rice & wheat). The exclusive S.K. Oil FPS Dealers have been given option either to purchase new e-PoS device from CSO-cum-District Manager by paying the full revised cost of the device (INR 33,630) or arrange for distribution of their monthly quota through the devices of the nearby composite FPSs. (FSCW Department letter no 16279 dated 17.08.2017) The sales register of exclusive FPSs those who have not purchased new PoS devices for sale of S.K. Oil, have been made available in PoS devices of nearby composite FPSs.

Allotment in favour of FPSs with less than 50 ration cards and suspended FPSs having FPL cards has been withheld. The list of such cases has been given in CSO/BDO/DEO login of RCMS (link no 13 to 15). It is requested to update such cases immediately.

The District Civil Supplies Officer is to download Wholesaler-wise/Fair Price Shop wise Distribution list from the system in CSO login of OTPDS URL [www.pdsodisha.gov.in](http://www.pdsodisha.gov.in) (link given in MIS Report section-"Allotment SK Oil") for each Block and ULB and communicate it to the concerned BDOs/EOs/Sub Collectors/ADMs/Wholesalers/FPSs for further action at their level. Concerned Blocks & ULBs can also download the Allotment in their respective RCMS login in above OTPDS URL. The FPS-wise Sales Registers have also been generated as per the above allocations and made available in the RCMS Login in MIS Report Section under "Sales Register of S.K. Oil" link for the Blocks and ULBs to download and use during manual transaction if any after approval of BDO/EO/Sub Collector/ADM as the case may be. The FPS-wise Sales Register has also been made available for download in the e-PoS devices of those Fair Price Shops which have received the devices to carry out PoS based distribution of S.K Oil entitlement of beneficiaries. This should be downloaded in PoS device after 1<sup>st</sup> date of the allotment month and distribution should be made accordingly through PoS device.

- I. Per card entitlement of S.K. Oil shall not be reduced below the prescribed allotment. Minimum 25% verification of sale will be conducted by the Inspector of Supplies/ACSO in charge of the Block/ULB every month.
- II. The distribution of S.K. Oil shall be undertaken during as per the datelines above of the allotment month during which all the dealers will keep their shops open and keep sufficient stock for the Consumers.
- III. Undistributed allotment of S.K. Oil will be considered as Opening Balance while finalising the allotment for the next month.

Copies of S.K. Oil allocation may be made available to concerned MPs/ MLAs/Chairpersons of Blocks/ULBs for their kind information.

You are requested to ensure distribution of S.K. Oil to the NFSA beneficiaries.




