Background:

Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya Sangathan is a path breaking initiative of Govt. Of Odisha to provide quality teaching in English medium at Secondary level for the children especially in semi- urban or rural areas and to give scope to rural talents who are unable to afford English medium education, state Govt. decided to implement the scheme and establish one Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya in all 314 blocks of the state phase wise.

Basically Odisha Adarsha Vidyalayas will have good infrastructure and facilities with stipulation on Pupil-Teacher ratio, ICT usages, holistic educational environment, appropriate curriculum and emphasis on output and outcome. The objective is to provide high quality English medium Education to the rural talents.

Key features of Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya:

- The objective is to provide high quality English medium Education to the rural talents.
- Vidyalaya will have holistic and integral approach touching upon physical & aesthetic development in addition to academic.
- The Vidyalaya will have adequate ICT infrastructure and internet connectivity.
- There will be sufficient scope for sports and co-curricular activities.
- There is provision of Art, Music and Computer Teacher besides subject teachers.
- Special emphasis will be given on teaching of Science, Math and English.
- There is provision of well equipped laboratories and library.
- Medium of instruction is English and the Vidyalaya is affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi.
- The Vidyalayas will have appropriate pace setting activities, so that Vidyalayas in the neighborhood can benefit from it.
- The classes will be from VI to XII having two (02) sections in each class with intake capacity of 40 in each section.
- The reservation of seats for students will be as per the percentage of SC & ST population in the respective Blocks at Entry level (Class-VI).
- All efforts will be made to make it really a centre of excellence.

Curriculum for +2 Higher Secondary (Science Stream)

(A) Scholastic Areas:

- 1. The Science Stream of each school will have 80 seats
- 2. There will be 5 subjects in class-XI. These are
 - (i) English Core (Code 301)
 - (ii) Mathematics (Code 041)
 - (iii) Physics (Code 042)
 - (iv) Chemistry (Code 043)
 - (v) Biology (Code 044)
- 3. There is no alternative subject in addition to above 5 subjects. All 5 subjects of class-XI will be continued to class-XII without any change.
- 4. Each subject carries 100 marks.
- 5. The physics, Chemistry & Biology subjects have practical of 30 marks and theory of 70 marks.
- 6. In English & Mathematics there will be 20 marks for Internal Assessment and 80 marks for pen paper test.

- 7. In Mathematics the students have to do 10 activities in a year as per the list and guidelines provided by NCERT Laboratory Manual. Accordingly internal marks will be awarded as per their activities performed.
- 8. In English the Internal Assessment (20 marks) will be totally based on Assessment of Listening and Speaking skills.
- 9. Each subject will be allotted with 8 periods. In Physics, Chemistry and Biology there will be 6 theory periods and 2 practical periods per week. In English and Mathematics there are 8 periods per week.

(B) Co-Scholastic Areas:

The Co-Scholastic activities are used as both cognitive and non-cognitive development of students can take place by exploring the child to the lesson on scholastic subjects and non-scholastic subjects. Each school has to keep following three co-scholastic subjects:-

- (i) General studies.
- (ii) Health & Physical Education.
- (iii) Work Experience.

There will be allotment of periods each week to each co-scholastic area and assessment will be done through grades.

How to Apply

The application form (attached herewith) can be printed/photocopied or can be obtained from the Vidyalaya and the application complete in all aspect along with list of enclosures can be submitted in the office of OAV Chakapad, Kandhamal latest by 25/08/2022.

Admission Guidelines:

- > Intake capacity:
 - Science- 80 (02 Sections with 40 students each)
- Subject Combination:
 - English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology.
- > There shall be no qualifying marks to apply for admission in Odisha Adarsha Vidyalayas in class-XI.
- > All notification & Circulars issued by CBSE shall be followed for subject combination in Class XI.
- ➤ The students who have passed from OAV including students selected for Iconic OAV where class X is upgraded to class XI shall be selected first in order of their merit determined on the basis of marks secured in CBSE class-X examination.
- > Students who have passed from the OAV including students selected for Iconic OAV, where class X is upgraded to Class XI shall be admitted in that OAV, inorder of merit determined on the basis of marks secured in CBSE Class X examination.
- ➤ If any student of other OAVs of the district who has been selected for Iconic OAV BBSR where Class XI Science is not opened for 2022-23 academic session, He/She shall be given preference for admission next to admission of students of the concerned OAV selected for Iconic OAV.
- > Students selected for Iconic OAV BBSR is eligible for taking admission in science stream only.
- ➤ If seats are still found vacant, students of other Odisha Adarsha Vidyalayas of the district may be considered for admission on the basis of merit.

- > If, still seats remain vacant, the admission may take place in the following order of preference
 - I. Students of the Govt / Govt. Aided High Schools within the same block.
 - II. Students of Private High Schools within the same block.
 - III. Students of Govt / Govt. Aided High schools of other blocks of the district.
 - IV. Students of the Private High schools of other blocks of the district.

This practice shall continue till class XI is opened in all Odisha Adarsha Vidyalayas. After opening of Class XI in all OAVs following steps shall be taken for selection of students.

In all cases the selection shall be on the basis of merit i.e. the marks secured in their last CBSE/BSE/ICSE examination.

- 6) Resident certificate

- ➤ Caste Certificate (For SC/ST/OBC only) issued by the competent authority (Original + one self attested copy).
- Proof of Address (Original + one self attested copy).
- > Aadhaar card (Original + one self attested copy).
- ➤ Bank A/c details (Original + one self attested copy).
- > Proof of Blood Group (Original + one self attested copy).
- > Two passport size recent coloured photographs excluding the one pasted on the application form.
