This is to notify that the Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government, SSEPD Department, Odisha, Bhubaneswar has instructed vide resolution No.2967/SSEPD, dated.05.04.2021 regarding selection of NGOs for running of the following amenities in the Integrated Infrastructure Complex (IIC), Sartaguda, Phulbani.

- A). Home for Senior Citizens
- B) School for Intellectual Disabled
- C) Early Intervention Centre
- D) Advance Rehabilitation Centre (ARC)

Accordingly, the District Administration Kandhamal, Phulbani invites applications in the prescribed application form –“A” & Part-“B” from the interested NGOs (NGOs can have their registered office in any district inside the state of Odisha) for running Home for Senior Citizens, School for Intellectual Disabled, Early Intervention Centre & Advance Rehabilitation Centre (ARC). An NGO can be also selected for running of multiple institutions.

Criteria for selection of NGOs are enclosed in a separate sheet for reference of the interested NGOs.



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5. Selection of NGOs/ Management:

- a. Option 1: Existing school management/ NGO is allowed to use the infrastructure at the IIC for running the school. The NGO will relocate the special school to the IIC. The premises will not be handed over to the management and will continue to remain under the administrative control of DSSO and maintenance will be with R&B Department. Management will run the school as per the guidelines of SSEPD department. District administration will identify the NGO following due process.
- b. Option 2: Corporate houses become mentor/ sponsor for a special school. Applications in this regard will be submitted to the Collector and the Collector will recommend such cases to SSEPD Department after due scrutiny by the District Level Committee. In such cases the sponsor/corporate house may identify the NGO/Organization to run the institution and recommend to the Collector. Selection of NGO will be finalized jointly after due consultation between the Collector and the Sponsor. Students from existing special schools will be relocated to the school. The corporate house can fund partial/ additional capital

expenditure. Corporate house will meet the entire running cost. Management will get full autonomy for recruitment/ disengagement of staff. Guidelines of SSEPD department will be amended for these schools for providing additional autonomy. Sponsor will provide handholding for a finishing school and employment/ further studies thereafter. They will also support self employment options of the students. Government Approval will be necessary in this regard.

6. Selection of NGO in case of Option 1 (in para 5):

- a. Application: Collector of the district will invite application from interested NGOs (NGOs can have their registered office in any district inside the state of Odisha) for running old age homes, home for the destitute, special school for VI, special school for HI and school for those with intellectual disability. An NGO can be also selected for running multiple institutions.

Collector will also invite application for running physiotherapy centre and mobile medical unit within the IIC. NGOs will need to fill up the form as placed in **Annexure Z** while applying. Following committee will be formed in the district level for selection of NGOs.

- 1) Collector - Chairman
 - 2) ADM -Member
 - 3) CDMO-member
 - 4) DSSO-Member Convener
 - 5) DEO-Member
 - 6) Any other member(s) to be co-opted by the Collector
- b. **Criteria for Selection of NGOs at District level:** NGOs will be chosen purely based on technical evaluation. 50 marks will be given for the parameters mentioned in the application form (**part B in Annexure Z**). Another 50 marks will be for the technical presentation. Decision of the Committee will be final in this regard.

7. Security at the main gate and the common areas will be provided by the department. However, concerned management/ NGO will be responsible for providing security inside the premises of the individual units. Security will be ensured round the clock.

8. There will be a consultant, assisted by support staff to coordinate among different NGOs managing individual units. In case of any dispute between any two or more NGOs, the decision of the Consultant will be binding.
9. A centralized kitchen will be made operational in each IIC. Its operation will be outsourced to a competent organization. A committee will be constituted under the chair of the Consultant, with participation of managing NGOs for overall supervision the centralized kitchen.
10. Release of Funds: Funds will be released in two instalments to the management (NGO). The first instalment will be released to the management during the first week of April. On submission of the inspection report and UC for the previous year, the second instalment will be released during September.
11. Separate electric meter will be installed for the common areas. Electricity dues for the common areas will be paid separately by the department. Electricity dues for the individual units will be paid by the management and the cost will be built into the overall management cost.
12. Outcomes: Increase in the numbers and proportions of older persons and PwDs can be expected to have far reaching economic, social and political implications. In Odisha the number of older persons and PwDs are increasing faster than the number of people in the traditional working ages, leading to a larger task ahead. However, the IIC complexes will have the following outcomes:
 - a. All 30 IIC complexes will provide shelter to 12000 persons including senior citizens and children with disabilities initially.
 - b. The IIC complexes will have provision for medical care, therapeutic services, counselling, assistive devices and physical rehabilitation services for all the inmates.
 - c. Support will be provided to children with disabilities for special or inclusive education, vocational training and other rehabilitation guidance.
 - d. PwDs and senior citizens will avail opportunities for yoga and meditation, sports, spiritual, cultural and other recreational facilities.
